Space: The camp will take place in Kaunas Artists' House, a spacious modernist villa, located in one of the oldest and culturally richest parts of the city. This will be the "home" of the camp and all of the activities (except for the excursion) will happen in the building or yard of KAH.

The participants will be accommodated in the old town of Kaunas, a historic monastery building. The participants will stay in shared rooms 3 to 5 people in one room.
